Additional fees include: Office Fee \$2/horse, Stall Fee of \$10/day (two horse/stall maximum) OR \$5/horse tie out fee if not using stalls, and camping fees of \$30/night if using electricity. Show management reserves the right to split or combine classes depending on entries. All color classes will be judged 80% color and 20% confirmation. **All stalls must be cleaned completely, and all bedding/manure dumped in the assigned dump location on the west end of the barn before you leave the grounds.** Once entries are made with the show office, no refunds will be allowed.
