Flat Rate Class Package	\$150 (Class Fees that total more than \$150 for a single horse)

This is an AMHA approved show and will be conducted under the rules and regulations of AMHA. AMHA rules now allow qualification for the World Show to be under two judges at two separate shows. AMHA points will follow the AMHA Standard Point System. Please refer to the 2018 AMHA Rule Book and any added rule changes for all questions. You do not need to be an IMEC 2019 member to show, but all horses must be AMHA registered and all paperwork current to participate in this show.

- The Hendricks County Fairgrounds is a beautiful facility just a short drive from Indianapolis that offers state of the art equine services. The Barn is connected to the covered show arena by a covered walkway to keep exhibitors out of inclement weather if needed. Clean restrooms and showers are available close to the barn and show arena. Warm water wash racks are available. A food concession stand will be available for lunch daily.
- Hotel Information – There are several hotels located in Avon and Plainfield that offer competitive rates.
- No arrivals prior to Noon, Friday, June 7<sup>th</sup> allowed without prior notification to Show Manager – Joyse Banister at 317-727-5153. All out of state horses must have a negative Coggins within 12 months and health certificate pulled within 30 days of arrival to show grounds.
- Campsites – You may camp at one of the many campsite locations on the grounds for \$30/night.
- Entry Forms – Entry forms must be complete with signature. Make sure you put your contact number and e-mail address on your entries. Include copies of both sides of the AMHA registration paper for each horse entered, any lease information, copy of youth and/or amateur cards, Stallion Verification Form, and complete payment with entries. Exhibitors are welcome to leave open checks for any POST ENTRIES that they have. Classes will not be added unless an open check is on file or you are paying when post entry is made. **Class additions must be made at the show office, and must be made at the show office at least 20 classes before the class begins.** Show entries may be mailed to: Joyse Banister/Hoosier Gold, 2799W 650N Fairland IN 46126. All checks are to be made out to IMEC. There is a \$30 returned check fee. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY MAY 25<sup>TH</sup> TO AVOID LATE FEES. Flat Rate Class Package only applies to entries that have classes totaling more than \$150 for a single horse. Office, stall and AMHA fees still apply. Refunds are only issued with a veterinary certificate, indicating the reason the horse is unable to participate in this show. The office fees, AMHA fees, and stall fees are not refundable.
- Flat ribbons will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> place in each class. Grand and Reserve Champion winners will be awarded rosette ribbons and Supreme Halter winners will be presented neck sash & trophy. High points will be awarded to Youth Exhibitor, Amateur Exhibitor, Performance Horse, Driving Horse, and Halter Horse (includes open age groups, championships, supreme, stock, and color classes!).
- Registration Papers/Stallion Certificates/Gelding Status – A copy of both sides of the registration papers for each horse entered must be included with your entries (or an official letter from AMHA). Your horse will not be entered without AMHA registration papers except for weanlings. Weanlings must have a valid AMHA number to show. All paper work must be up to date with AMHA. Stallions three years or older must have a copy of the AMHA Senior Stallion Verification Report. Gelding Status must be reflected on the registration certificate for horses to be shown in any AMHA classes.

- Youth and Amateur Cards – Copies of the 2019 Youth and Amateur cards are required with show entries. Both youth and amateur applications will be available at the show office at AMHA rates. These will be sent to the organization and a card will be issued to the exhibitor. Please remember to include a copy of your current 2019 card with your entries.
- Measuring – Horses must be measured prior to receiving back numbers. All horses must meet their age height requirements. If your horse measures into a different class size that horse must show in the class which matches its official show measurement. Scheduled times for measuring are Friday 5-8pm and Saturday/Sunday from 7am-8am. The show will start promptly at 8am. Check-in will be from 5-8pm on Friday and at 7:00am on Saturday. Please notify the show management if you must measure at a different time.
- Shavings must be ordered with your pre-entries by May 25<sup>th</sup>. If you do not order shavings, make sure you bring your own, as the fairgrounds does not sell shavings and we will be getting our pre-ordered shavings from an independent source. Straw is not permitted on this fairgrounds.
- Unsportsmanlike Behavior or any type of animal abuse will not be tolerated. Anyone found in violation of either of these will have their entries cancelled and must leave the grounds immediately upon request. No refunds will be issued.
- Gate Call – We will use a two minute gate call. Be sure to check in with the entry gate when arriving for your class so that the show can continue to move at a steady pace. Gate holds must be requested at the gate at least two classes ahead. If you have back to back classes, please have both horses at the gate. We will use our PS System to make barn calls. This is a courtesy provided by the facility. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to check on the show status and know when they need to be at the gate for their class.
